



RESPONSIBLE SOURCING POLICY

Husky Plywood, Ste-Therese division, is a decorative hardwood plywood manufacturer, which buys components (multiple species of veneer; cores of particleboard, MDF and veneer core) to laminate veneers on a core, meeting a specific request from a customer.

*We believe in sustained yield forestry management,
to maintain the perennity of our resources and perpetuate our art !*

We make the commitment to evaluate our suppliers, in order to reduce significantly the risk that they would supply us wood from unacceptable sources, that doesn't meet the requirements of « **FSC Controlled Wood** » (FSC-STD-40-005).

Our suppliers must confirm to us, that they implement best efforts to avoid purchasing wood from the following categories :

- Illegally harvested wood
- Wood harvested in violation of traditional or civil rights
- Wood harvested from forests in which high conservation values are threatened by management activities
- Wood harvested from areas being converted from forests and other wooded ecosystems to plantations or non-forest uses
- Wood from forests in which genetically modified (GM) trees are planted

We use a stringent method to analyze that risk, in order to assure our customers that the panels we supply them, are in compliance with a responsible forest management, environmentally, socially and economically.
